

## MATERIALS BANNED FROM WISCONSIN LANDFILLS

### Banned from disposal in 1991

- Lead acid batteries (automotive).
- Major appliances (air conditioners, clothes washers and dryers, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, ovens, microwave ovens, dehumidifiers, furnaces, boilers or water heaters).
- Waste oil.

### Banned from disposal in 1993

- Yard waste, including grass clippings, leaves, yard and garden debris, and brush under six inches in diameter.

### Banned from disposal in 1995

- Aluminum containers.
- Corrugated paper or other containerboard.
- Plastic containers #1 (PETE) and #2 (HDPE).
- Glass containers.
- Magazines and other materials printed on similar paper.
- Newspapers and other materials printed on newsprint.
- Office paper.
- Steel containers.
- Containers made from a combination of steel and aluminum (bi-metal cans).
- Waste tires.

## MATERIALS "DISCOURAGED" BY LANDFILLS

*(partial listing of common household hazardous wastes which should be taken to Clean Sweep)*

Artist and hobby paint	Antifreeze
Cleaner w/ ammonia	Brake fluid
Cleaner w/ bleach	Carburetor cleaner
Disinfectants	Degreasers
Drain and toilet cleaners	Gasoline, fuels
Floor/wax stripper	Transmission fluid
Household batteries	Windshield washer
Metal cleaners	Adhesives, glues w/solvents
Mothballs	Concrete cleaner (acid)
Oven cleaners	Furniture stripper
Polish & spot removers	Glaze, spackle
Polish w/ solvents	Glue (water based)
Thermometers (mercury)	Oil-based paint
Driveway sealer	Paint remover
Latex paint	Paint thinner
Fertilizer w/weed killer	Putty, grout, caulk
Fertilizer (no weed killer)	Stain, varnish, lacquer
Insect or bug killer	Turpentine
Lighter fluid	Wood preservative
Pool chemicals	Weed killer
Rat/rodent poison	Rechargeable batteries (nickel-cadmium)
